Following the governments lock down announcement, as of Thursday 2nd November, Roger, Jon and Tracy will be relaunching our takeaway menu.

This time round we are pleased to include Twynning community as well as Ryall, Naunton, Ripple and Uckinghall parishes for collection and delivery.

Throughout the week we will be offering the following options:

- Beef Lasagne with Garlic Bread
- A selection of Homemade Pies (Fillings will Vary)
- Homemade Curry with Rice and Naan (Options will Vary)
- Cottage Pie
- Vegetable Lasagne (V)
- Spinach and Ricotta Cannelloni (V)
- 3 Bean Chilli (V)

These will be served pre-cooked in plastic takeaway containers, and if not heating up straight away, can be refrigerated or frozen at home. The price is £7.50 for each dish purchased.

Weekends:

On Friday evenings only we will also be serving Cod & Chips or Scampi & Chips with either mushy or garden peas. Price is £8.95 for each of these meals.

On Sunday lunchtimes only, we will be offering Sunday Roasts. There will be a choice of 3 meats (Beef + 2 other options) with all the trimmings including vegetables and cauliflower cheese. There is also a vegetarian Nut Roast option. Price is £7.50 for each item purchased.

PLEASE NOTE this product will be served pre cooked and cold and will need heating up when you get home. Should you wish to collect your meal, we advise you bring your own plates for Rog to serve the meals on.
